Title: All the Fun of the Fair

Communication Language and Literacy

English:

We will be looking at a variety of texts to support and stimulate our writing experiences. These will be based on real fairgrounds when looking at non-fiction (leaflets, advertisements and posters)

We will be writing creatively about the thrills and excitement of being at a fairground through poetry and descriptive writing.

ICT:

We will be developing our ICT skills to research and then present our findings about fairground rides and designs. We will also be learning about being games developers and

Physical Development and PSHE

PSHE:

We will be following our new Jigsaw scheme with the new focus being on Changing Me.

PE: We will be working through the Real PE curriculum which looks at the skills used for ball games (passing, catching, balancing, and hand-eye co-ordination) and playing games.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

SCIENCE:

In Science, we will be learning about forces.

- explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object itself.
- identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces.
- recognise that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

History:

We will be learning about the history of fairgrounds and how they have evolved over time. This will include looking at transport and how the rides have been adapted.

RE:

We will be studying Christianity and the Ten Commandments.

Mathematical Development

The main focus at the start of this term:

Geometry - properties of shape:

- identify different sized angles
- estimate and draw given angles.
- identify regular and irregular polygons.
- identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation.

We will be continuing to practise our times table knowledge through our daily Rock Star Maths challenge.

Weekly arithmetic lessons will be on a Friday. Further practise of the skills taught within school will be set on MyMaths for pupils to try at home.

Creative Development

We will be making a moving fairground ride based on what we have learnt in all of our lessons. Lowry will be the artist which we focus on and we will be re-creating some of his famous paintings of fairground scenes.
