Title: Where in the world is Barnaby Bear?

Communication Language and Literacy

Literacy:

- Children will use their phonic skills to write for different purposes e.g. dinosaur descriptions, diary entry, postcards, stories, menus.
- Use the book 'Dear Zoo' and adapt to ask the dinosaur museum for a pet dinosaur.
- Children will continue to review sounds they have previously learnt and learn new sounds.
- Children will continue to practise their blending and segmenting skills to read words and sentences, we will be focussing on fluency and comprehension.

Communication and Language:

- Develop language skills in our dinosaur museum and cave role play areas.
- Learn and use new vocabulary linked to dinosaurs.

Physical Development and PSED

PSHE:

- Jigsaw theme is Changing Me.

Physical Development

- Penpals handwriting sessions will continue. As part of transition to Year 1 the children will write in handwriting books.
- REAL P.E. sessions will focus on ball chasing and static balance: floorwork.
- Hedgehogs P.E. takes place on Monday and Thursday. Rabbits P.E. takes place on Monday and Friday. Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school during the school week and earrings are removed.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

The World:

- Dinosaurs - learning dinosaur names, looking closely at similarities and differences between dinosaurs e.g. herbivores and carnivores.
- Comparing our local environment to environments further afield e.g. the seaside, Italy, Africa.

RE:

- Discovery R.E. theme is Special Places. Key question: What makes places special?

Technology:

- Select and use technology for a purpose.

Mathematical Development

Number:

- Addition.
- Subtraction.
- Number bonds.
- Solving problems and reasoning.

Shape, space and measures:

- Consolidating knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes. Recognising 2D shapes in different rotations and sizes.
- Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.

Creative Development

- Choose own techniques and materials to create representations of dinosaurs.
- Explore art and music inspired by Africa.
- Explore Italian artists and the techniques they used.
