Title: The Great Fire of London.

Communication Language and Literacy

Key Text:

We are looking forward to learning all about the 'Great Fire of London' using a variety of texts.

We will be using our non-fiction texts to develop and improve our writing, demonstrating writing for different purposes. Through our learning we will be writing a recount, diary entry, fire poems and a fact file.

ICT:

We will be developing our ICT skills on a weekly basis and become story tellers. We will be recording each other retelling stories.

Physical Development and PSHE

PSHE:

We will be following our new Jigsaw scheme with the new focus being on relationships with families and friends.

PE: We will be working through the Real PE curriculum which looks at the skills used for ball games (passing, catching, balancing, and hand-eye co-ordination) and playing games.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about plants and what they need to survive. We will be planting seeds and understand how we need to look after them. Also we will look at different parts of plants and what they do.

HISTORY:

As we are learning about the Great Fire of London we will be looking at the difference between Tudor lives and how we live now. We will research Tudor houses and compare them with our homes.

RE: Beliefs and Moral Values.

We will be looking at Judaism and sharing key traditions.

Creative Development

This term we will be designing and making 3d Tudor houses. We will also look at colour mixing to create fire pictures by mixing paint and using pastels.

Mathematical Development

The main focus at the start of this term:

Year One and Two data and measure:

- Tally charts.
- Pictograms.
- Different ways to measure.
- Understanding capacity.
- Telling the time.

We will also we support the Year 2 children to do their very best in their SATS.

We will be continuing to practise our times table knowledge through our daily arithmetic. Further practise of the skills taught within school will be set on MyMaths for pupils to try at home.

We will learn how to bake bread and use our measuring maths skills to help us.
