#### DESIGNER ART COMPETITION INFORMATION

- The Designer Art Competition for children/young adults up to the age of 18 years old across Rushden is part of our year long heritage project “1918-2018, Then & Now” ending with a celebratory event on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2018 celebrating 100 years of remembrance.
- Entrants are being asked to produce a “**unique pin badge for the Rushden Branch Royal British Legion’s Poppy Appeal**” of their own interpretation- ***Please note due to copyright a 2 petal poppy is not to be used.*** This can be using paint, crayons, pencils or other craft items.
- Entrants are asked to only use size A4 paper or card so that as many as possible can be displayed for the event. Card has been provided for you.
- Artwork should be clearly marked on the back with the name of the artist, their age and the school/club details.
- Schools/clubs are being asked to internally judge and submit their top 3 for the final judging by the Mayor of Rushden and local Legion members on March 29<sup>th</sup> 2018.
- The 5 top winners will have their badges produced ready for the 2018 poppy appeal. The winners will be presented with their produced badge, certificate and a £15 voucher and the school/club the entrant is from will receive a £25 stationary voucher.
- If your child would like to take part then please could we have your entries handed into school by **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March.**
