Create a wanted poster for a criminal who has committed a typical Tudor crime	Create a miniature version of stocks, which were used as a form of punishment. Think carefully about your choice of material.

All homework projects will receive recognition of effort through a certificate and the awarding of Forest Points. The homework projects will also be put on display for children and parents to share and for the children across the school to see and enjoy.
