Dear Parents,

Please find a PGL Kit List below we have highlighted the essential items in bold. The children are away for 3 nights and 4 days so they need to be prepared for all eventualities with the British weather so please make sure they have sufficient clothing to wear. They will be outside whatever the weather so if it has been raining they need alternative clothing to put on.

On the day the children will be able to come to school in their own clothing for PGL. Please note that we do not advocate buying new clothes for the trip, the older the better, as they may get wet and muddy.

- **T-Shirts (at least 2 per day)**
- **Long-sleeved t-shirts (Many of our activities require these as part of the risk assessment)**
- **A waterproof jacket**
- Waterproof trousers are handy but not essential if it is raining heavily
- **Jumpers**
- **Trousers (not jeans) (at least 3 pairs)**
- **Leggings or Sports trousers**
- **Underwear & socks (pack plenty of spares!)**
- **Clothes for the evening – remember it could be chilly and we will be outside.**
- **Pyjamas**
- **2 pairs of trainers – they must be able to be tied up**
- **A towel**
- A small rucksack
- **Sleeping bag or duvet**
- **Pillow**
- **Shampoo/conditioner**
- **Shower gel/soap**
- **Toothbrush and toothpaste**
- **Hairbrush**
- **Deodorant (roll on only as no aerosols are permitted)**
- **Sun cream**
- **A hat**
- **Plastic bags (for wet clothes)**
- **A water bottle**
- Something comforting (teddy)
